

Local Order No. (4) of 2000
Exempting Commercial Establishments from Payment of
Cash Security Deposit upon Applying for Discount Permits¹

We, Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Chairman of the Dubai Municipality,

After perusal of:

The powers legally vested in Us pursuant to the Order Establishing the Dubai Municipality;
Local Order No. (114) of 1997 Regulating the Sale at Reduced Prices in the Emirate of Dubai; and

The presentation of the Director General of the Dubai Municipality,

Do hereby issue this Order.

Article (1)

Commercial Establishments licensed under the legislation in force in the Emirate of Dubai to conduct commercial and business activities are hereby exempted from the requirement to pay the cash security deposit stipulated in Article (9) of the above-mentioned Local Order No. (114) of 1997.

Article (2)

This Order will form an integral part of the above-mentioned Local Order No. (114) of 1997 and will be read therewith.

Article (3)

This Order comes into force on the day on which it is issued, and will be published in the Official Gazette.
