

Decree No. (63) of 2009
Exempting Companies and Corporations from
Fines for Failure to Renew Licenses¹

We, Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Ruler of Dubai,

After perusal of:

Law No. (35) of 2009 Concerning Management of the Public Funds of the Government of Dubai;

Law No. (25) of 2008 Concerning the Economic Development Department;

Law No. (4) of 2005 Imposing the Knowledge Dirham Fee and its amendments; and

Law No. (7) of 1995 Concerning the Financial Regulations of Government Departments in the Emirate of Dubai, and

With a view to supporting the various economic sectors in the Emirate of Dubai,

Do hereby issue this Decree.

Article (1)

The companies and corporations working in the Emirate of Dubai, including the Special Development Zones and the free zones, are hereby exempted from all fines imposed on them for failing to renew their licenses by the dates prescribed by the legislation in force.

Article (2)

The exemption stipulated in Article (1) of this Decree is limited to the companies and corporations that comply, no later than the end of June 2010, by renewing or cancelling their licenses, or suspending their activities for a specified period.

Article (3)

This Decree comes into force on the day on which it is issued, and will be published in the Official Gazette.
