

Decree No. (11) of 2011
Concerning
Following up Government Claims being Considered by the Courts¹

We, Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Ruler of Dubai,

After perusal of Public Prosecution Law No. (8) of 1992 and its amendments;
Government Claims Law No. (3) of 1996 and its amendments;
Law No. (32) of 2008 Establishing the Government of Dubai Legal Affairs Department; and
Decree No. (16) of 2009 Concerning Government Claims,

Do hereby issue the following Decree:

Article (1)

The Government of Dubai Legal Affairs Department shall represent the Government of Dubai and its departments, authorities and public corporations in all claims and appeals under the above mentioned Decree No. (16) of 2009 Concerning Government Claims, and shall take all necessary actions in respect of them.

Article (2)

The above mentioned Decree No. (16) of 2009 shall be repealed.

Article (3)

This Decree shall come into force on the day on which it is issued and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
