

Regulation No. (1) of 2013
Amending Regulation No. (3) of 2009
Concerning the Unified Fare Scheme for Public Transport in the Emirate of Dubai¹

We, Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai, Chairman of the Executive Council,

After perusal of:

Law No. (3) of 2003 Establishing the Executive Council of the Emirate of Dubai;

Law No. (17) of 2005 Establishing the Roads and Transport Authority; and

Regulation No. (3) of 2009 Concerning the Unified Fare Scheme for Public Transport in the Emirate of Dubai,

Do hereby issue this Regulation.

Article (1)

Article (13) of Regulation No. (3) of 2009 Concerning the Unified Fare Scheme for Public Transport in the Emirate of Dubai (the “**Original Regulation**”) will be superseded by the following:

Article (13):

- a. The provisions of the legislation applicable to public car parks in the Emirate will apply to car parks of Public Transport Facilities and Services with respect to regulating their use and recording the violations committed in breach of such provisions, but not to the fees for using such car parks.
- b. The use of car parks of Public Transport Facilities and Services will be free for users of Public Transport for the first twenty-four (24) hours. Fees will be imposed on non-users of Public Transport as follows:
 1. ten Dirhams (AED 10) per hour or part of an hour where the parking period is up to five (5) hours;
 2. fifty Dirhams (AED 50) where the parking period is more than five (5) and up to twenty-four (24) hours;

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3. fifty Dirhams (AED 50) per day or part of a day where the parking period is more than twenty-four (24) hours and up to five (5) days;
4. three thousand Dirhams (AED 3,000) for reserving a parking space for six (6) months; and
5. five thousand Dirhams (AED 5,000) for reserving a parking space for twelve (12) months.

Article (2)

The Table of Violations and Fines (Table 3) attached to the Original Regulation will be replaced by the Table attached to this Regulation.

Article (3)

This Regulation will be published in the Official Gazette and will come into force on the day on which it is published.

1	Using Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services, or entry into/exit from areas where fare is applicable, without payment of the applicable fare.	200
2	Failure to present the Unified Card upon request.	200
3	Using a card designated for others.	200
4	Using an expired card.	200
5	Using an invalid card.	200
6	Using a counterfeit card.	500
7	Selling Unified Cards without prior permission from the Authority.	200
8	Damaging, vandalising, or destroying equipment or seats on Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	2,000
9	Spitting, littering, or performing any act that would compromise the cleanness of Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	200
10	Causing a disturbance or inconvenience in any way to users of Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	100
11	Smoking inside Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	200
12	Carrying hazardous items, including weapons, sharp tools, or inflammable materials, inside Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	1,000
13	Carrying alcoholic beverages inside Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	500
14	Selling or promoting, in any way, goods and commodities inside Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	200
15	Failure to comply with the instructions of the inspectors or authorised personnel of the Authority or obstructing the performance of their duties.	200

16	Misusing lifts or escalators.	100
17	Boarding the Public Transport Facilities and Services by climbing or jumping..	100
18	Using Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services contrary to the Authority's instructions posted on signboards.	200
19	Entry into restricted areas inside Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services in violation of posted warning signs and boards.	100
20	Opening the doors or attempting to access or leave Public Transport while it is moving between stations and stops..	100
21	Accessing or sitting in areas designated for specific categories.	100
22	Bringing animals into Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services, except guide dogs for blind persons.	100
23	Carrying or using materials or equipment that may cause inconvenience to users of Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services or endanger their safety.	100
24	Using any security or safety device or tool, including emergency exits where it is not necessary.	2,000
25	Sleeping in passenger shelters or any place where sleeping is prohibited.	300
26	Causing any distraction or visual obstruction to the driver of Public Transport while he is driving.	200
27	Standing or sitting in non-passenger areas inside Public Transport and Public Transport Facilities and Services.	100
28	Putting feet on seats.	100
29	Eating and drinking in areas where eating and drinking are not allowed.	100
30	Parking vehicles in areas designated for metro users for a period exceeding the permitted period.	100 per day and up to AED 1,000
